

RESOLUTION NO. 1214-23

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A PORTION
OF ROCKFIELD PARK AS A MEMORIAL GROVE

WHEREAS, the Town of Bel Air has a large community who cherish and wish to memorialize their deceased love loved ones; and

WHEREAS, remembering beloved family members becomes a way of healing the hole left by their passing and dealing with the grief of a lost family member; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Bel Air would like to provide a place to commemorate family by allowing for the purchase of a tree in their honor more specifically identified on the attached Exhibit A; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Bel Air Board of Town Commissioners recognize that a dedication of park space is needed to provide for families to honor their deceased loved ones and a small space between the ball fields in Rockfield Park and the adjacent Chesapeake Sensory Playground offers such a location. Rockfield Park is unique for such a commemoration area given its prolific location to walking paths and its access to residential neighborhoods.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the area described will be reserved for the planting of trees and erection of markers and be known as the Rockfield Park Memorial Grove.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Board of Town Commissioners that this Resolution shall become effective upon the date of its passage.
