

Ordinance No. 833-24

An Ordinance Amending Bel Air Town Code Chapter 165. Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulations, Part 2. Zoning, Article II. Administration and Enforcement, § 165-17. Economic and Community Development Commission

WHEREAS, Chapter 10. Boards, Commissions and Committees, Article II. Economic and Community Development Commission, § 10-5. Membership; terms of office; compensation; officers; meetings; quorum of the Bel Air Town Code indicates that the Economic and Community Development Commission (ECDC) shall consist of an odd number of members, but not fewer than five nor more than nine. This section of the code also defines the terms of office for the ECDC.

WHEREAS, Chapter 165. Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulations, Part 2. Zoning, Article II. Administration and Enforcement, § 165-17. Economic and Community Development Commission indicates that the Economic and Community Development Commission, as established by the Bel Air Town Code, consists of nine members.

WHEREAS, the Bel Air Board of Town Commissioners wishes to align § 165-17 with § 10-5 so both sections indicate that the ECDC shall consist of an odd number of members, but not fewer than five nor more than nine.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Town Commissioners that the Town of Bel Air Town Code, Chapter 165. Comprehensive Plan and Development Regulations Part 2. Zoning Article II. Administration and Enforcement § 165-17. Economic and Community Development Commission, shall be amended by Ordinance No. 833-24, as follows:

The Economic and Community Development Commission, as established by the Bel Air Town Code, consists of **AN ODD NUMBER OF MEMBERS, BUT NOT FEWER THAN FIVE NOR MORE THAN** nine ~~members~~ who act as the Town's community development agency. ~~The term of each member shall be three years or until his/her successor takes office.~~ The Chair is **SHALL BE** elected annually by the Economic and Community Development Commission members.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance shall become effective on the twenty-first (21st) day after passage unless petitioned to referendum.
